I am writing you to explain to you my story. I was involved in a motorcycle accident in 1990. It was a pretty serious accident.

Years later, I had ear reconstructive surgery done. I went through several surgeries. The first surgery was eight hours long. I had to have skin grafts done. That was major surgery and it took weeks to recover. I also had one more smaller surgery done to add more detail to the reconstructed ear.

Unfortunately, after the final surgery and recovery, I was not satisfied with the results. The reconstructed ear did not look realistic.

So, I decided to have the reconstructed ear removed. After I was fully healed I went to see Bob Barron. He made a prosthetic ear for me. The ear he created for me is very realistic looking. I am very happy with the new prostheses. Bob Barron did a terrific job!

I would just like to make others aware of how much pain, grief, and suffering is involved in the ear reconstructive surgery process. Hopefully I may be able to save other people from having to go through this experience.

Especially young children. I would never want to see a young child have to go through what I went through.

Surgery can be avoided by contacting Bob Barron. He can create a prosthesis, without surgery. His work is truly miraculous!
